- Evaluate field installations and recommend design modifications to eliminate machine or system malfunctions.
- Coordinate equipment installations at customer site.
- Integrate and install peripheral equipment.
- Ensure quality product installation from set up to initial operation.
- Train customer maintenance and contractor employees on how to operate the equipment.
- Assist customer maintenance team to troubleshoot equipment.
- Service and repair company equipment in the field as needed.
- Available to travel as need for business purposes up to 50%.

- Electrical Engineering Technology degree and/or 3 to 5 years equivalent experience
- Minimum of 2 years of field service experience, preferred
- Strong working knowledge of electrical and safety standards

- Familiarity and experience with the interpretation of blueprints and electrical/engineering schematics
- Able to define problems, collect data, establish facts, and draw valid conclusions.
- Able to think strategically and identify critical success factors when developing strategy and plans for assigned area of responsibility. Ability to translate diverse pieces of information into meaningful conclusions and results.
- Must have a valid driver's license.
- Successful completion of a DOT physical and drug test.

**Work Environment:** Inside manufacturing building; areas may be non-uniformly heated or air conditioned. Exposed to dust, oil, grime, fumes, and industrial lubricants. Noise level moderate, and may require hearing protection. Eye protection and other PPE required, i.e. safety shoes. While traveling, may work in outdoor conditions for equipment installation or service. Must be willing and able to drive and/or ride long distances.

**Physical Requirements:** Average level of physical exertion is medium to high. Required to bend, kneel, stoop, crawl, twist, stoop, stack, push/pull and balance while stocking, storing, and maneuvering around the work area. Must be able to lift minimum of 50 lbs. Required to stand and walk for long periods of time.
